Dear Commissioner Kruzeniski:

I write to you today regarding concerning reports of personal information being inappropriately shared through the provincial government's hunting and angling licensing system.

Many people have reported on social media and through the offices of M.L.A.s in the Official Opposition that they have received emails from the provincial government containing the name and Hunting, Angling and Trapping License (HAL) number of a different person. These reports are extremely concerning, and I ask that your office investigate whether a breach of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* has taken place.

I also ask that you consider whether this potential breach is in any way related to the previously reported breaches of personal information your office has identified at eHealth and/or at Saskatchewan Polytechnic. I also ask that you consider what role the American company that the government has outsourced Saskatchewan's hunting and angling license system to has played in the potential breach of personal information.

I have attached images of the social media posts for your information.
